The Pokfield Campus will be a new landmark hub at Pokfield Road. The development of the new campus also aspires to improve the community's environment and walkability.


DISCOVER HKU'S FUTURE-READY POKFIELD CAMPUS

Reimagining Academia through Technology

Blending the best practices of traditional higher education with modern technologies, the dynamism of hybrid teaching and learning that will be available at Pokfield Campus will facilitate interdisciplinary collaboration – a key to driving innovation.


High-speed Wi-Fi will be available throughout the campus, while all classrooms and lecture theatres will be outfitted with advanced interactive video conferencing systems that have cross-device wireless sharing capabilities, making teaching and learning more versatile and personalized.



World-Class Audiovisual Provisions

The centrepiece of Pokfield Campus will be a 300-seat auditorium with state-of-the-art audiovisual designs, including large high-resolution LED screens and theatre-quality stereos, serving as a new venue for holding major conferences and seminars for esteemed scholars and business leaders from around the globe.

The new campus' "Windows of the World" (WOW) Room is an interactive learning space featuring a semicircular LED display wall, allowing students and staff from on-site and remote to interact or exchange their collective research findings through the integration of virtual and reality settings.



Empowering Innovation & Excellence

State-of-the-art teaching facilities including the Bloomberg Lab are also planned for Pokfield Campus, preparing students for real-world situations by accessing platforms used by world-leading institutions and corporations to enhance their skills and gain hands-on experience in financial data research and analysis.

The digital infrastructure in the new campus will provide the HKU community and researchers with high-speed computational capabilities, facilitating cutting-edge research in digital transformation, AI and big data.

DESIGNED FOR STUDENT-CENTERED HOLISTIC WELL-BEING



In addition to academic and research excellence, the overall planning of Pokfield Campus also aims to offer a sense of ease and foster a healthy lifestyle for members of the HKU community.

Reminiscent of lush green hillsides, the design of Phase 3 Academic Complex seamlessly integrates with the building's rooftop garden and green podiums to create a feeling of being enveloped and nurtured by nature.





Imitating streams that wind their way around mountain slopes, the design of public walkways within the Pokfield Campus includes a variety of landscaping and water features — such as terraced gardens, cascade steps, and reflection pools with waterfalls —that add a sense of natural movement and life to the overall environment.




Engaging Spaces

Sports Facilities


Succeeding the former Flora Ho

A SMART, INCLUSIVE AND SUSTAINABLE CAMPUS

Pokfield Campus aims to promote the University's values of inclusivity, equal opportunities, resource efficiency, and sustainable development to all members of the HKU community through smart campus management.





Sustainable Campus

Sustainable features have been integrated into the planning of Pokfield Campus, including natural lighting and rainwater recycling systems. Greening elements such as at-grade planting, vertical greening and green roof, combine to reduce the carbon footprint of the development.

The intelligent building management systems in the new campus allow for the adjustment of indoor lighting, heating, and air conditioning systems in real time, achieving the goal of energy efficiency and reducing carbon emission.



Enhanced Accessibility

Assistive technologies like indoor positioning systems are applied throughout Pokfield Campus to help visually impaired users navigate their way around. Accessibility features including textured flooring, wheelchair access and accessible toilets are also provided for campus users with impaired mobility.

HKU also proposed building escalators linking the new campus with Kennedy Town. The improvements being planned aim to improve accessibility and the pedestrian environment within the district.

Community Engagement

HKU is committed to delivering upgraded campus facilities and enhancing the environment of the neighbourhood through the Pokfield Campus development. The University continues to engage with stakeholders and the community throughout the development process.

"HKU Cares" Student Sports Ambassador Programme







In Q3-Q4 2023, to promote "active ageing" and intergenerational inclusion in the Pokfulam community, HKU partnered with

Caritas Mok Cheung Sui Kun Community Centre to launch a community sports ambassador pilot programme to train HKU students to lead fitness classes designed for senior citizens and participate in new sports experience, improving their health and social connections. As of end November 2023, HKUCares Student Ambassadors have served over 200 residents.
