



TEMPORARY VEHICLE ACCESS POINT AT JCSVII BETWEEN MORRISON HALL & SUEN CHI SUN HALL (JUN-AUG, 2026)

To facilitate the development of HKU Pokfield Campus while alleviating heavy traffic on Pok Fu Lam Road and Pokfield Road, **a temporary vehicle-only access point** is anticipated to be established between Morrison Hall and Suen Chi Sun Hall.

Planned in coordination with the feedback from Hall Wardens and management, appropriate safety and mitigation measures are in place to support a safe daily routine and minimise disruptions throughout this temporary arrangement.

IMPLEMENTATION PERIOD

June to August, 2026

Full reinstatement is scheduled prior to the Fall semester.



STRICT OPERATING HOURS

9:30AM to 4:30PM daily (Mon-Sat)

Heavy vehicle are prohibited outside these hours to avoid peak student commuting times.



AUTHORISED USAGE

Exclusively for scheduled materials delivery only (Light and Medium Goods Vehicles). This is not a general access point for construction workers.



WHY THIS ROUTE IS NEEDED

Facilitate the loading and unloading process of construction materials to support timely project completion.

DEDICATED SAFETY ARRANGEMENTS

SAFETY & MITIGATION MEASURES

Clear Pathways: A clear, unobstructed 900mm-wide dedicated pedestrian walkway will be maintained at all times to safeguard daily transit to-and-from the hall.

Traffic Wardens: Personnel will be stationed at the temporary vehicle access point during operation hours from 09:30 to 16:30 daily, to assist pedestrians with crossing safely.

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY REMINDERS

Follow Guidance

Strictly follow the instructions of on-site traffic wardens at all times.



Stay on Path

Use designated walkways only and avoid unauthorised shortcuts.
